




STAGE 5A


STAGE 5B

YEARS 11-12 STAGE 6

If you're leading large groups of students or need material for a special event, our Stage 6 *Think Faith* seminars could be just the ticket. There are 8 seminars, each covering a hot topic question. The seminars are designed to get students thinking, help them explore the Bible, and offer creative video resources to help bring the topics alive.

STAGE 6A

Term 1A: What is the meaning of life?

Why looking at creation leads Christians to believe there is a creator. What the Bible says about the unique role humans have in creation.

Term 2A: Jesus: fact or fiction?

The stories of Jesus' life, miracles, death and resurrection are not only written about in the Bible, but have historical evidence to back them up.



Term 3A: Jesus: dead or alive?

Why do Christians believe in the most unbelievable part of the Christian story, to the point of being willing to die for their belief?

Term 4A: Jesus: myth, martyr or made-up?

What would it have been like to hang out with Jesus? Top bloke? Religious nut? Or something else entirely?

STAGE 6B

Term 1B: Is God good?

Term 2B: Why aren't Christians perfect?

Term 3B: Why isn't the Church perfect?

Is church a building? A social club? Is it a group of goody-goody killjoys? Maybe the church is something else entirely?

Term 4B: Why is Jesus worth paying attention to?

This seminar wraps up all that students have learned in senior high and junior high, as well as primary school and asks: What does Jesus have to do with me?
